The World in a Box

Culture Boxes representing 47 different countries provide you a wonderful hands-on learning opportunity. The boxes contain clothing, games, videos, books, toys, musical instruments and other artifacts from around the globe. You can touch, feel, and immerse yourself in elements of other cultures.

Emily Wood started this program in 1993, with the help of Tulsa Global Alliance and Eisenhower International School (EIS). Boxes are housed at EIS and can be checked out by any group or organization on a two-week basis.

Teachers across the state agree that Culture Boxes promote critical thinking, as well as avenues of visual, auditory, and tactile learners. Culture Boxes provide teachers with an educational tool, and many boxes contain a curriculum to aid in classroom presentations.
